Perhaps this is because Being requires Becoming, perhaps, as well as static existence – and to become is to become something more, or at least something different. That is only possible for something limited.”

The hero who is a hero because of a God who cannot be a hero is a fool not a hero. Foolhardy and hero cannot be said in the same breath.
